If you would like to change your class level, please attend the Japanese language course orientation on April 8 (Mon.) and let us know your request. - ① Undergraduate Students, Exchange Students
- Please contact your faculty regarding the period and process for class registration
- All the students need to complete their class registration at their faculty. Each faculty has its own period for class registration. Please contact your faculty's academic section.
- ② Graduate Students
- Please write an E-mail to the instructor in charge of the class you wish to take and apply for the status of "Credited Auditors". if you meet all task requirements for the classes, you will be awarded credits and credit certificates.

- Forms will be distributed at the Japanese language course registration meeting on April 8. The forms are also distributed at the following offices: Academic Affairs Section, Faculty of Engineering, International Student Center (127, Main Building)
 - Place of submission: Academic Affairs Section of your graduate school
 - Deadline for submission
 - Japanese1, Japanese3 : Wednesday, April 17
 - Industrial Japanese: Tuesday, April 23
 - This procedure is not required for "Japanese 2".

- 1. Credits for Japanese subjects are NOT considered required credits for graduation for graduate students.
- 2. For the application for the status of "Credited Auditors", you need permission from your supervisor.
- 3. The application form of "Japanese1" and "Japanese3" must include the seals of your supervisor and the instructor in charge of the class. Please bring the application form to class the first week.
